

# "A Role Model for My Son"

"My purpose in life is to give my son something I never had – a father," Shen Campbell told the judge. The fight for custody of his son, Jeremiah, had become a "whirlwind of disaster".

This ordeal started in 2005 when Shen's marriage deteriorated. A native of Brooklyn, he moved to Colorado Springs in 2007 to get a fresh start. Meanwhile, Jeremiah did not want to visit his mother in

Florida, but a court order required him to do so.

When Shen's son failed to return at the appointed time, Shen got in the car (at risk of losing his job) and drove from Colorado to Florida to get him back. "God, I'm trusting You," he prayed. After he arrived, Shen didn't even know where to start looking, so he went to the sheriff's office. Not knowing Shen, or the situation, they were not about to help.

"I needed to make a stand," Shen continued. He made his case and finally they agreed to help. What normally would have taken weeks, happened in a matter of hours.

"God, I'm trusting You."

They found Jeremiah on a military base. Upon seeing his father, he ran across the street into Shen's waiting arms. Jeremiah

kept saying, "I don't have to come back here again." The sheriff was moved to tears at the sight of the reunion.

Months later and standing before the judge deciding custody and child support, Shen was determined to be the father for Jeremiah that Shen never had, and affirmed, "I want to be a role model for my son." Seeing the love of this father, the judge awarded Shen sole custody of his son.

An employee at Memorial Hospital, Shen has had extraordinary support from the staff. One encouraged him to apply for a Habitat house. Knowing Jeremiah's fondness for Spiderman, a physician donated a bedroom set just before closing on their home.

Shen and Jeremiah moved into their new Habitat house on Christmas Eve in 2007. Their joy was uncontainable. That night, in his boy's room amongst all-things-Spiderman, Shen held Jeremiah close in his arms. "I held a little bit of heaven."

Since moving into their home, Shen has remarried and was blessed in this new family with a step-daughter and a newborn boy.

"I needed to make a stand."

"I want to be a dad the right way. I can sacrifice my desires for my family. I owe all my blessings to God. I'm grateful."



The Mulitauopeles have paid it forward in raising their children and seeing their achievements, and now they are paying it forward to another family that will experience a greater self-sufficiency as homeowners. Gabe adds, "I am truly happy that another family will be blessed like we were."
