Sorpresa Lane Fire

Colorado Springs, CO (February 5, 2018) – Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity has been notified of a fire in Woodmen Vistas development on Saturday, February 3, 2018 at Sorpresa Lane (near Black Forest Road and East Woodmen Road) that directly affected five Habitat homeowners. We are certainly saddened by this event and offer assistance as best we can to the homeowners who suffered property loss. Woodmen Vistas is a neighborhood that was built in partnership with Rocky Mountain Community Land Trust, and was completed in 2016. Thirty-seven families reside there as Habitat homeowners.
