# Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity Dedicates New House for Family of Five

**Fountain, CO** (June 16, 2018) – Sonni and Karen with their three children (one who is severely autistic) live in a small 2-bedroom townhome in an unsafe neighborhood. They were in dire need of a larger house to achieve safety and stability for their family.

Sonni and Karen helped build their house alongside volunteers. Each Habitat house is 90% volunteer-built, making it that much more affordable for families. Building costs average \$150,000 per house, and Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity (PPHFH) relies on sponsorships to cover the construction costs. This house is a special project -- a Blitz Build -- sponsored by CSI Construction Company. With the help of their subcontractors and suppliers donating services and materials, CSI graciously sponsored and built this house.

- 3. Turn left onto Comanche Village Drive and take the first right onto El Paso Street.
- 4. Take the first right onto Bunting Avenue, and then the first left onto Red Finch Lane. House will be near the end of the cul-de-sac on the right-hand side.
