**Fountain, CO** (May 1, 2018) – At her Habitat ground blessing celebration last year, Patricia shared that she lost her mother when she was 10 years old and hasn't had a home since then. Sitting in the doorway of her framed-in Habitat house, she proudly said, "This is my home."

With limited physical mobility and other health issues that require monitoring, Patricia lives in a two-level apartment, and stairs are an obvious barrier. Even though restricted by physical concerns, Patricia worked on her house as much as she was capable with tasks matched to her ability, filling in her required sweat equity hours with administrative help in our office, and volunteering at our ReStore. Patricia will soon have a safe and affordable home. Her own home. And that means the world to her.

4. Take the first right onto Bunting Avenue, continue to Red Finch Lane and the house will be at the end of Red Finch Lane in the cul-de-sac.
