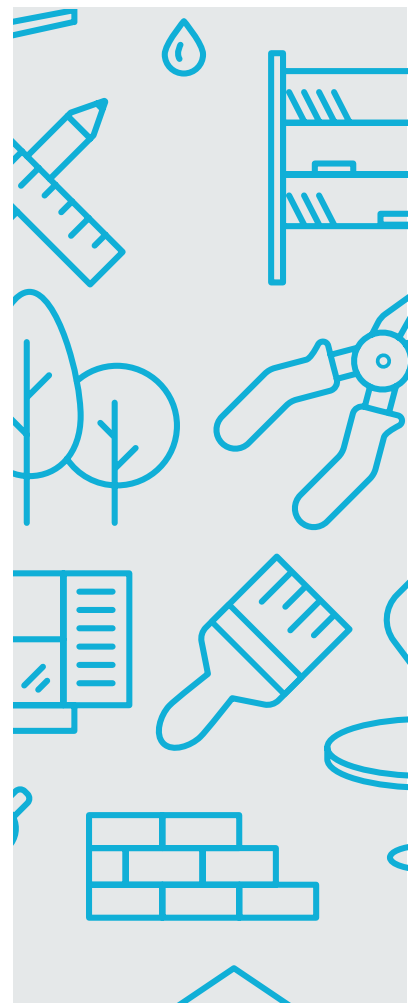

At Habitat, we look to address the affordable housing crisis by giving a hand up rather than a hand out. We provide permanent, affordable housing opportunities to individuals and families to own a quality home. We empower families and individuals to live better, healthier, and more sustainable lives.

Applicants are vetted on a situational basis to ensure a healthy experience for all parties involved. Our programs require rigorous financial and homeowner education, and each family or individual is required to put in at least 200 hours of sweat equity into building their home. With the help of donors and volunteers, Habitat builds homes and provides affordable mortgages to the qualifying future homeowners.
