A LOOK BACK AT NEPAL

In FY19, Nepal HFH completed numerous achievements, including:

- Supported 3,655 families with new or improved shelter
- 939 new houses built
- 222 incremental shelter solutions
- 274 community members and government officials trained
- 6,855 youths engaged in awareness-raising events

HABITAT POUR L'HUMANITE COTE D'IVOIRE

Introducing our newest Tithing Partner:

- Established in 1999, Habitat for Humanity Côte d'Ivoire seeks to break the cycle of poverty by working with homeowners to provide safe, dry and secure homes, with decent sanitation.
- Due to a devastating civil war and global economic pressure in 2002, the country contends with extreme poverty.
- Annual Housing Deficit is estimated to be 40,000 to 50,000 units per year.
- Programs include: Housing Orphans in Protected Environment (HOPE), decent housing for disabled and low-income families, financial education, and water, sanitation and hygiene.

ORPHANS AND VULNERABLE GROUPS

Supports the efforts of Habitat for Humanity organizations to provide adequate shelter and other interventions for particularly vulnerable people in communities around the world. FY19 OVG program included:

- \$100,000 to expand support of ex-bonded laborers and their families in **Nepal**.
- \$100,000 to help orphans and vulnerable groups in **Lesotho**.
- \$99,000 to serve families with children with microcephaly and motor disabilities in **Brazil**.
- \$90,000 to enhance inclusion for people with disabilities through housing and sanitation in **Vietnam**.
- \$88,200 to improve the housing conditions of people with disabilities in **Myanmar**.
