Support Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity on Colorado Gives Day

Colorado Springs, CO (Dec. 4, 2019) – Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity (PPHFH) invites Coloradans to support affordable housing in El Paso County by donating to us on Colorado Gives Day, December 10, 2019.

Presented by Community First Foundation and FirstBank, Colorado Gives Day is an annual statewide movement to celebrate and increase philanthropy through online giving. The event is powered by ColoradoGives.org, a year-round, online giving website. To increase awareness of our organization, PPHFH kicks-off Colorado Gives Day at CityROCK (21 N. Nevada Ave., Colorado Springs), our venue sponsor, helping to raise the issue of affordable housing to new heights. CityROCK and its onsite restaurant and bar, The Ute & Yeti, are donating 10% of their sales to PPHFH. Our Colorado Gives Day sponsor is ANB Bank, generously matching donations up to \$4,000 made to PPHFH on Dec. 10 through ColoradoGives.org.

In conjunction with activities at CityROCK, we are hosting our first <u>Gingerbread Home Build</u> to benefit our <u>2nd Annual Veteran Home Build</u>. Children of Habitat families decorated individual gingerbread houses, along with local businesses that sponsored each house at \$160 (0.1% the cost of a real Habitat house at \$160K). The title sponsor, Caliber Home Loans, has donated \$1,600 to fund the event. The finished gingerbread houses are currently on display at PPHFH's ReStore (411 S. Wahsatch Ave, Colorado Springs) Dec. 4 - 10, and customers will be encouraged to vote with donations in person, by text, or online. Each house has its own donation canister, and the three houses with the most donations will receive first, second and third awards. Public viewing at the ReStore will be during normal business hours, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday - Saturday.

PPHFH staff will move each gingerbread house to their corresponding sponsor's business location on Colorado Gives Day, and voting by donation will continue with the help of each company's customers until Dec. 17. On Dec. 18 the houses will go home with each Habitat family, and the winners will be announced on Dec. 19. Voting opportunities and locations of each house for viewing are available on our website.

Community First Foundation and FirstBank each contributed \$500,000 to create a <u>\$1 Million</u> <u>Incentive Fund</u>, one of the largest gives-day incentive funds in the country. Every nonprofit receiving a donation on Colorado Gives Day receives a portion of the fund, which increases the value of every dollar donated.

Community First Foundation, a leading foundation dedicated to fueling the power of community to drive positive change, and FirstBank, Colorado's largest locally owned bank, have partnered to present Colorado Gives Day for the past eight years. By making fundraising simple for nonprofits and giving easy for donors, it is one the most successful events of its kind in the nation.
