#### **PPHFH Status Update**

Mr. Probert provided a status update on PPHFH:

- 5 areas to our work at habitat:
  - Advocacy-to advocate for decent, affordable housing
  - Retailer-ReStore
  - Land Developer
  - Constructer-2<sup>nd</sup> largest home builder in the U.S.
  - Affordable Mortgages

- For the time being, our construction sites are able to be open and will be operating with our staff only
- Office staff-all working remotely
- Working to see if our ReStore can remain open

## **Community Build – 3 Simultaneous Homes**

- We have received feedback from PPHFH Directors, and will move forward with all 3 builds as part of the Interfaith Build for Unity
  - It is possible to have the homes built simultaneously
  - o Development is across the street from Aragon Elementary
  - General volunteers, volunteers from other groups, etc. community as a whole will all be involved

## **Ground Blessing Update**

- We were originally planning for the Ground Blessing to be Sunday May 3rd
- It is likely that this will need to be pushed back at least a few weeks
- Still need to begin planning for this
- Thoughts/ideas for the Ground Blessing ceremony:
  - Music is unifying, would be great to include children
  - Videotape Ground Blessing to be featured on everyone's website and/or social media
  - Goal to have many speakers representing different faiths
  - Would want community leaders from Fountain to be a part of the Ground Blessing
  - Bringing tools as gifts to the Ground Blessing is an idea
    - Construction team is in the process of inventorying everything
    - It is possible that there is a need for more tools given the volunteer count, and simultaneous building

## Volunteering Schedule Option

- We have permission to volunteer on Sundays, this is new for our staff as they have never worked at the construction sites on Sundays before
- We are making this change to accommodate everyone
- CERVIS is our online volunteer registration system
  - Will have times slotted throughout the year and entire operation of the build
  - Signups encouraged ahead of time to reserve your spot
  - Waiver is to be filled out online
- We will have a few rounds, by doing these rounds we will be able to gage the demand and not have too many volunteer slots open or too few
  - Round 1: one Saturday and one Sunday per month, for each of these days slots for 2 groups (5 from each group)
  - Round 2: 4 groups up to 20 people at a time

 Since Sundays are typically an off day for our construction staff, we would add a second Sunday potentially because we need to balance the amount of supervisors per volunteers

#### **Action Items**

- Think/Plan about forming group Sub-Committees
  - What would the structure look like?
  - Potential sub-groups could include:
    - Event Planning
    - Outreach
    - Coordinate lunchtime food to be inclusive of everyone

#### What's needed from the Committee? (To be continued in future meetings)

- Brainstorming, dreaming, and planning
- o Advocacy
- Event Planning (Kick-off event? Ground Blessing and Home Dedication)
- May be good to break off into sub-committees for certain tasks such as food
- o Volunteer Recruitment and Outreach to New Partners
  - Examples:
    - African-American Churches (AME, Missionary Baptist, etc.)
    - Asian-American Churches (Chinese, Korean, Vietnamese, etc.)
    - Eastern Orthodox (Holy Theophany)
    - GuruGhar (Sikh)
    - Hindu Community
    - Latter Day Saints
    - Spanish Churches
    - Unitarian Universalists, and more...
