 - Pastor Stecker: Suggestion for larger tarps for lunch time. Had a great response, and it was a very positive experience and felt meaningful both days.
 - Mrs. Jodeh: Had Husband, son and some representatives attend. All had a positive experience. 16-year-old son wanted to do more but limited due to age, but great experience and will hopefully get back out there as well.
