On day three of our initiative, Pikes Peak Habitat invites you to learn about one tangible way that you can support interfaith efforts in our local El Paso County community through the Interfaith Build for Unity (IBU).



1 OVERVIEW

This monumental movement brings together volunteers from a variety of different backgrounds, beliefs, spiritual practices, and faith traditions to work together in unity to help build affordable homes in El Paso County for local families, uniting around the idea that everyone deserves a decent, safe place to call home.

2 HOW IT WORKS

We are bringing together congregations & communities from a variety of traditions to volunteer, side-by-side, to build affordable homes for local families. Our IBU volunteer days are a time of celebrating tolerance, cooperation, and love for one's neighbor. Here is how it works:

- 1) Invite 5 members of your community to volunteer (no experience necessary)
- 2) Your group will be paired with a team of local volunteers from a different tradition. The two groups will work together on the construction site, will talk together over lunch, and will stand unified as friends and equals.
