# Pikes Peak Habitat ReStores Promote Donation Drive for 2022 Earth Day

**Colorado Springs, CO** (April 14, 2022) – The theme for Earth Day 2022 is *Invest In Our Planet*, and Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity (PPHFH) is challenging our community to donate a record-breaking amount of goods to the two local ReStores as a way to keep those items out of the landfill. Donations to the ReStores are recycled and resold with net proceeds helping serve more families in El Paso County in need of affordable housing. The 2022 Earth Day ReStore Donation Drive is sponsored by <u>Keysight Technologies</u> to continue making El Paso County a greener place in 2022.
