Superintendent's Message

As a long-serving superintendent in the Pikes Peak region, I have watched as social upheaval steadily erodes our ability to educate the children of our community. Like flash floods that scour through downstream structures, society's challenges hit our children the hardest. When children come to school hungry, tired, or anxious, it is immensely more challenging to bring out their academic potential. Tragically, the number of children living in cars or surfing on couches keeps climbing. Without safe and stable housing, students constantly struggle to make progress.

That reality is part of what motivates me to serve with Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity. Every year, volunteers and donors help build affordable housing to shelter our students and the families that love them. Every time we bless a house and hand the keys to a new homeowner, our community has reached into the stream and pulled a vulnerable child onto solid ground. Since 1986, Pikes Peak Habitat has helped families build and purchase homes that have sheltered over 400 local students. Nine more students will move into their own homes in the next several months, but we need your help.
