Program requirements

- Mobile home repairs will not be a part of this home repair program. Manufactured homes may be considered if set on a permanent foundation. Determination will be made upon assessment. PPHFH reserves the right to determine property eligibility on a case-by-case basis.
- Home must be located within El Paso County.
- Applicant must be the recorded owner and live in the home, as their primary residence.
- Home should be insured.
- Mortgage payments must be current.
- Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity will complete a home inspection, by appointment, to assess the repair needs.
- Pikes Peak Habitat will do a search on the sex offender registry on ALL adult members of the household.
- Household income must fall below 2023 Annual Maximum of Area Median Income (AMI):

HOMEOWNER CONTRIBUTION

Based on the project costs and the income of the applicant, the homeowner's contribution is a non-refundable \$25 assessment fee should your application proceed to the assessment stage.

WILLINGNESS TO PARTNER

To be considered for the program, you and your household members must be willing to partner. This is what is called "sweat equity" by Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity. Applicant(s) must contribute some of their time, up to 8_hours maximum. See below for sample ideas. Applicants are required to turn in *complete* applications. Each applicant is expected to be present and engaged on their Home Repair site while Habitat staff and volunteers are working. Volunteering as a form of Sweat Equity should be something new, rather than a continuation of something you are already doing. PPHFH may modify the sweat equity requirement, depending on the homeowner's situation.

Sweat Equity Ideas:

- Tell, record or write history of the community to share with a publication or PPHFH
- Write thank-you's to service organization
- Be part of a neighborhood phone tree to check on fellow residents
- Read books to neighborhood children at the library
- Share favorite recipes with neighbors
- Make cookies for a service organization
- Help start or maintain a community garden
- Teach a skill to another person
- Make or create something for someone
- Other ideas are welcome
