Pikes Peak Habitat Releases Fiscal Year 2024 Year in Review

Annual publications and video show milestones in supporting affordable homeownership in El Paso County

Colorado Springs, CO (Sept. 26, 2024) — Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity has just released its annual Year in Review materials for fiscal year 2024 (July 1, 2023-June 30, 2024). A data-driven executive summary, a booklet with quotes and photos, and a highlight video showcase various aspects of the affiliate’s work in promoting affordable homeownership here in El Paso County, Colorado, as well as throughout the world.

Highlights of Pikes Peak Habitat’s work in FY ’24 include

- Completing construction on **5** new homes in partnership with El Paso County workforce families
- Completing **1** recycled home (a home built by Pikes Peak Habitat that was returned to us and renovated in partnership with a new homeowner)
- Completing **77** repair projects focused on health, safety, accessibility, and aging in place
- Partnering with **2,927** volunteers
- Diverting **2,291** tons of materials from landfills through ReStore sales and recycling
- Raising more than \$1 million to support affordable homeownership through ReStore sales
