

What can Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity Restores accept as an in-store or pick-up donation?

Thank you for thinking of Pikes Peak Habitat Restores! Your donations help Pikes Peak Habitat for Humanity accomplish our goal of building strength, stability, and self-reliance through shelter. Free donation pickups may be scheduled for donations of at least two items over the phone at 719.667.0841 or online at PikesPeakHabitat.org.

Please Note: Exceptions may be made by drivers, receiving, and management. Some items that may otherwise be stated as acceptable—especially new, packaged, and unopened goods—may be denied due to current store needs. Goods that may be unsafe for Pikes Peak Habitat employees and volunteers to handle may also be denied. Donation pick-ups must be ready in a garage or outside of your home for our driver's safety.

Appliances

Freon-operated appliances (refrigerators, freezers, AC units, etc.) can be donated for recycling even if they are not in working order. We charge a \$30 processing fee for **all** Freon-operated appliances, regardless of whether they will be resold or recycled.

Cabinets

We accept cabinet sets that are complete with doors, drawers, and shelves. Hardware is unnecessary but appreciated! Cabinets cannot be painted, water damaged, broken, or missing doors, drawers, and shelves.

Countertops

We accept countertops in good condition and straight pieces over four (4) feet. Counters cannot be banjo-style or have excessive markings, stains, chips, water damage, or sink cutouts.

Doors

All doors must be in good condition without holes from screws, nails, tacks, stickers, and hooks. Patio doors must be complete, seals must be intact, and frames must be free of hail damage. Doors must also be under eight (8) feet in height and unpainted. We cannot accept personally hung mirrored doors, firerated, painted, water-damaged, glass/shower, or cut doors.

Flooring

We cannot accept used materials, scraps, or open bags of grout or cement. Decorative mosaic tiles may be donated in any quantity. All tile must be free of grout and adhesives and may be donated in any quantity for the sake of recycling.

Furniture

We accept furniture items in good condition without rips, stains, missing pieces, water damage, excessive gouges or chips, pet fur (allergies), or foul/pungent odors. We cannot accept items such as bedding, mattresses, box springs, waterbeds/accessories, or baby furniture/gates/cribs. In addition, furniture items must not be painted. We also cannot accept China hutches, entertainment centers, hutches, TV cabinets, or TV armoires.

Other frequently denied furniture donations include loose glass for tables/desks, conferences tables, office desks, medical equipment, and electronics (batteries, TVs, computers, printers, exercise equipment).

Hardware and Tools

We accept many kinds of hardware and fasteners, and all handheld and electric tools. We ask that you please inform us of any broken or unusable tools so they may be appropriately recycled. Power tools must be empty of any oil or gas.

Insulation

We accept new rolled or sheet insulation. Unbagged insulation will not be accepted.

Lawn and Garden

We cannot accept or pick up any small rock, pea gravel, or river rock unless it is "clean" and in containers no larger than a five-gallon bucket (safe for lifting).

Lighting

We accept lighting fixtures. Light bulbs must be new in the box. Ballasts must be new in the box that clearly states "NO PCBs" on the label. Used bulbs, fluorescent bulbs, and fluorescent fixtures cannot be accepted.

Lumber and Trim

Acceptable lumber and trim must be four (4) feet or greater, in good condition, unwarped, free of water damage, free of all nails, and screws and adhesives.

Plumbing and Bathroom

All plumbing-related goods must be free of water damage, cracks, and mold. No water softeners will be accepted.

Toilets: ALL TOILETS MAY BE DONATED (even not stamped 1.6 GPF or less High Flow)! Those we can't sell are recycled into roadbed for the city. We accept toilets that may not be in working condition, with cracks, missing hardware, etc. Toilets must be stripped of all metal, plastic, wax ring, and flushing mechanisms. Only low-flow toilets (stamped 1.6 GPF or less) may be resold at the ReStores, and these must be in full working condition, with the seat, no cracks or missing hardware, and clean.

Windows

We cannot accept any windows damaged by hail or with broken seals, valances, window coverings, blinds, curtains, wood and plastic awnings, broken windows, unframed windows, mirrors, glass, and wood/aluminum-clad, metal-framed, or single-pane windows.

Recyclable (Material We Will Recycle for You)

We accept anything metal that you no longer have use for and would like recycled! We ask that you please let our associates know if your metal-based merchandise is intended for recycling. All recyclable materials and items intended for donation must be free of chemicals. We also accept tile, porcelain, paint, and some textiles.
