Decorated Studs Will Frame House for Veteran Family***

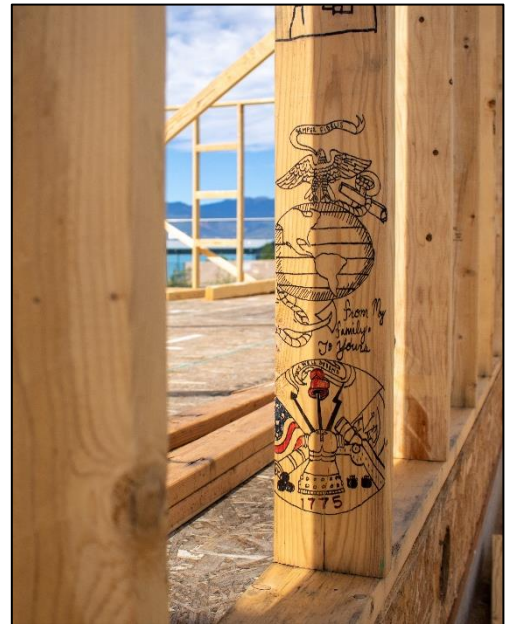
