GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The ReStore Donations Supervisor (RDS) supports the growth and success of the ReStore donations by overseeing daily and monthly operations, leading staff and volunteers, and ensuring both the quantity and quality of donated products. Reporting to the Director of ReStores, the RDS develops strategies to increase donations and partnerships, manages logistics of routes and schedules, and manages a team of drivers, driver assistants, coordinators, and volunteers. The RDS must be self-motivated, team-oriented, and knowledgeable about ReStores and thrift home improvement retail. This role requires strong leadership skills, the ability to build and inspire teams, and a commitment to advancing the PPHFH mission through the ReStores.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Hire, train, lead, and manage a team of Donations Ambassador Drivers, Ambassador Assistants, and Donations Coordinator in the function of their roles.
- Establish and manage all processes of receiving donations from donors and drivers.
- Provide a positive donor and customer experience to ensure that all interactions are positive and any concerns are addressed.
- Track and manage donations and relationships for the Dir. Of ReStores.
- Provide scheduling and logistic support for donations.
- In coordination with ReStore leadership, manage policy development and deployment in the areas of customer service, donor relations, ReStore operations, employee relations, safety, merchandising, donation acquisition, and volunteer management.
- Create, maintain, and follow all PPHFH ReStore Operations Manuals, Driver SOPS, and any other SOP that may be needed to ensure success.
- Create and manage local corporate relationships for donated products.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be an active part of the ReStore leadership team and be able to support the general operations of the ReStore, if needed.
- Actively seek out and participate in approved leadership development opportunities.
- Understand forecasting, sales reports, dashboards, and other metrics as required by the Dir. Of ReStores and ReStore Committee.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Knowledge and experience in retail sales, marketing, thrift, merchandising, volunteer and staff management, and nonprofit experience are preferred.
- Strong computer proficiency required with preference for experience with MS Office Suite.
- Experience working in a ReStore.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS NECESSARY TO PERFORM THIS JOB:

- Ability to adequately traverse a retail store; lifting /carrying a minimum of 75 lbs. frequently; plus, bending, twisting, reaching or other similar activities as required.
- Ability to drive a box truck and forklift vehicle.

- Some time spent at a desk in an office with no windows.
